2-3rd Grade Summer Camps

2-3rd Northwoods Campcraft June 23-27 \$250 We'll create our own woodland "camp," building shelters, foraging, and exploring in the forest. We'll learn and practice skills such as firebuilding, camp cooking, and canoeing. We'll harvest materials from the forest for baskets, bow and arrows, plants for dyeing fabric, and much more!

2-3rd Nature Investigators July 14-18 \$250We'll be taking our microscopes and magnifying glasses on many adventures around the farm as we explore pond life, observe birds in flight, study the texture of bark, and much more! We are excited to examine all of the reflections of our expressive God.

2-3rd Farmhands August 4-8 \$250Dive deeper into life as a farmer! Kids will get the opportunity to plant seeds, harvest crops, help with farm chores, and get lots of hands-on time with the farm animals. Each day will be a new learning experience in keeping the farm running smoothly.

2-3rd Heroes in Action August 18-20 (3 Days) \$150 We'll learn what it means to be a hero and challenge ourselves through superhero training. We will also dive into some different hero stories of the Bible. We may even meet some real heroes of our own.

K-1st Creativity in Creation June 16-20 \$250 We'll spend our time experiencing the beauty in nature that is a reflection of our creative God. We'll explore different areas of the farm and forest, and work with our hands to design projects and participate in activities that show how God cares about even the tiniest details around us.

K-1st Junior Explorers July 7-11 \$250 We'll learn what it takes to become a proficient outdoor explorer. Setting up shelters, cooking, map skills and more! We'll practice modes of travel, hiking in the woods, and canoeing on the pond. Soon you'll be guiding your family on their next outdoor adventure.

K-1st Pioneers July 28-August 1 \$250
We'll spend time living life on the farm and exploring the woods as the pioneers did! We'll bake bread in our wood-fired oven, as well as plant, cultivate, and harvest fruits and vegetables from the garden. We'll learn to shepherd our flock of sheep and care for the laying hens. We will do some crafts and activities that the early settlers would have done.
